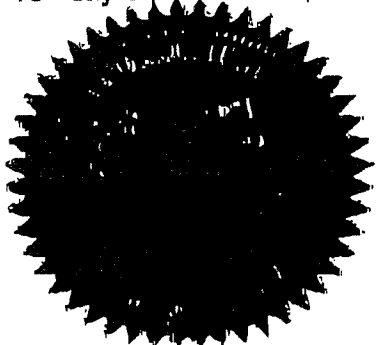
WHEREAS more than 1,500 volunteer cosmeticians, health care professionals and concerned individuals participate to make the program successful; and


