SUBJECT: Award of Tender No. 04-061 - Dartmouth Lawn Bowling Artificial

Surface Replacement

ORIGIN

2004/05 - Approved Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council:

- 1. Approve an increase in the Gross Capital Budget to Capital Account No. CPS00041 Lawn Bowling Upgrades, by \$40,000.00, with no change to the Net Budget, to reflect the cost sharing from Nova Scotia Sport and Recreation Commission, as per the Background section of this report.
- 2. Award Tender # 04-061 Dartmouth Lawn Bowling Artificial Surface Replacement to Marathon Athletic Surfaces for materials and services specified at the unit prices quoted for a Tender Price of \$119,860.00, plus net HST for a total amount of \$127,565.80 from Capital Account No. CPS00041, Lawn Bowling Facilities, with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications Section of this report.

BACKGROUND

In 1996, an artificial playing surface was installed at the Dartmouth Lawn Bowling Facility located in Woodside. This surface has outlived its life cycle and at the present time is unusable. The scope of work being purposed in this project will see the replacement of the artificial surface.

Funding for this project was approved for \$99,000.00 in the 2004/05 Capital Budget. Further staff applied for and received an additional \$40,000 from the Nova Scotia Sport & Recreation (Facility Development Program).

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called and closed on May 12, 2004 and one valid bid was received as follows: (Another bid was received, but was rejected as it did not meet mandatory tender requirements.)

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Increasing the approved Gross Capital Budget of Capital Account No. CPS00041 - Lawn Bowling Upgrades, in the amount of \$40,000.00, to reflect the cost sharing from Nova Scotia Sport and Recreation Commission, will not change the Net Budget.

Further, based on the lowest tendered price of \$119,860.00, plus net HST, for a total of \$123,970, funding is available in the 2004/05 Approved Capital Budget from Capital Account No.CPS00041 Lawn Bowling Upgrades. The budget availability has been approved by Financial Services.
