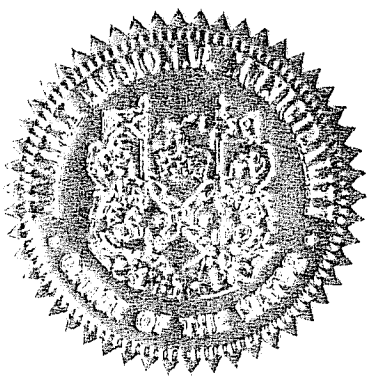



**THINK PINK WEEK
