## INFORMATION REPORT

### ORIGIN

Halifax Regional Council meeting dated August 17, 2004, item 9.2.1.

### BACKGROUND

Councillor Hetherington submitted a petition from the residents of Morris Lake Estates requesting that a crosswalk be installed at Caldwell Road/Morris Lake Drive. The Councillor requested that the petition be forwarded to the Traffic Authority and that the Traffic Authority meet with the Residents Association to discuss this issue.

## **DISCUSSION**

Pedestrian counts conducted at this intersection in September after the resumption of school verified that the warrants for the installation of a marked crosswalk were met. A regulation authorizing the installation was issued and the crosswalk signs and markings were completed on October 14, 2004.

The Morris Lake Estates Residents' Association was advised of the results of the study by email to Scott Graham, the originator of the petition.


