SUBJECT: Municipal Boundary Changes - District Activity and District Capital

ORIGIN

Change in the boundaries of Municipal Electoral Polling Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

• Council approve the methodology as outlined in the Discussion section of this report for the allocation of District Activity and District Capital Funds based on the new Electoral District boundaries.

BACKGROUND

The intent of the District Activity and District Capital funds is to provide financial resources to the Councillor of each electoral District in HRM in support of expenditures that benefit the district in which the expenditure is made. The funds are approved on an annual basis in conjunction with the annual budget process. The 2004/05 budget includes approval of \$3,000 for each Councillor's District Activity Fund and \$40,000 for each Councillor's District Capital Account. New Municipal Electoral Districts come into effect on November 2, 2004. Therefore, any unspent funds must now be allocated across the new electoral districts.

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DISCUSSION

District Capital

The District Capital funds are generally related to a physical asset which by its physical location can be identified to a particular district. Therefore, all expenditures and commitments which occurred prior to the election were reviewed by staff to determine the expenditures and commitments by the new electoral districts. The method used to determine remaining funds by new district was based on identifying where funds had been spent and committed as it relates to the new districts to ensure an as even a distribution as possible given the change in the district boundaries mid-way through the year. The total spent or committed in the new district was subtracted from the \$40,000 available to determine the amount available to be spent or committed for the remainder of the year. The total now available by new District is outlined in Attachment A to this report. A report of District Capital Expenditures and Commitments to September 30 based on the new district boundaries is included in Attachment B to this report.

District Activity

The District Activity funds tend to be smaller dollar donations and may not be identifiable to a specific location or district. They can include, for example, donations to the Heart & Stroke Foundation, Canadian Cancer Society, MS Society, Canadian Diabetes Association, Terry Fox Foundation, Autism Society of Nova Scotia, etc. Therefore, these were not reviewed down to the level of specific expenditure item, rather, the districts were reviewed globally, comparing on an overall basis the former district boundaries to new ones. Any unspent funds in a former district were transferred to the new districts based on this overall review. The total now available by new District is outlined in Attachment C to this report and a report on expenditures to September 30 is included as Attachment D.

General

It should be noted that the necessary allocation of unspent funds across districts is a one-time event and that any new funds approved by Council for the 2005/06 budget will be allocated equally across all districts. While staff have made every effort to review commitments and expenditures and

allocate based on the new electoral district maps, there may be instances where an item has been placed in an incorrect district. Approval of the overall methodology would not preclude Councillors from directing staff, with the mutual consent of the Councillors involved, to correct any errors that may have occurred in the allocation exercise where the overall result is consistent with the annual budget which provides for an equal allocation across all districts.

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BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

There are no budget implications associated with this report.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT POLICIES / BUSINESS PLAN

This report complies with the Municipality's Multi-Year Financial Strategy, the approved Operating, Capital and Reserve budgets, policies and procedures regarding withdrawals from the utilization of Capital and Operating reserves, as well as any relevant legislation.
