ORIGIN

At the Regional Council Meeting of May 17, 2005, Councillor Meade put forward a Notice of Motion to amend Section 2 of Administrative Order 33, Respecting Open Air Burning to add three communities: Bayside, Brookside and Lower Prospect.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

Council approve First Reading for the adoption of the Amendment to Administrative Order No. 33, Section 2 - to include the following communities in which a burning permit is not required, providing all requirements that are outlined in Section 13 of the By-Law O-103 are met: Bayside, Brookside and Lower Prospect
