ORIGIN

Halifax Regional Council Meeting of August 31, 2004, item 9.1.9, Prince's Lodge - Sewer and Water Servicing.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that Council:

- 1. award Tender No. 05-224, Prince's Lodge Sewer and Water Servicing to Sackville Trenching Limited for materials and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Tender Price of \$1,250,796 including net HST from Capital Account No. CGU00646, Prince's Lodge Water and Sewer, with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications Section of this report.
- 2. approve the appointment of O'Halloran Campbell Consultants Limited for construction inspection services for a total of \$37,706 including net HST with funding as outlined in the Budget Implications Section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Halifax Regional Municipality in cooperation with the Federal and Provincial Governments under the Canada - Nova Scotia Infrastructure Program has provided funding to construct sanitary sewer and water distribution systems in the Prince's Lodge area of Halifax. This project will provide servicing on Prince's Walk, Lodge Drive and Kent Avenue.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on April 16, 2005 and closed on May 4, 2005. The following bids, exclusive of taxes, were received:

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of the construction of sanitary sewer and water distribution systems including services to property lines, all associated reinstatement and all environmental protection measures during construction.

Since this project was designed by O'Halloran Campbell Consultants Limited, it is recommended that they be retained to provide construction inspection and administration services. The estimated fee for this service is \$36,455 plus applicable taxes. If approved, the payment to the consultant will be based on the amount of actual time spent on the project in accordance with the hourly fees quoted in the design proposal.

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

The Prince's Lodge project involves the installation of new sewer and water systems and therefore is subject to Local Improvement Charges as per By-Law L-118.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$1,209,328, plus net HST for a total project cost of \$1,250,796, funding is available in Account No. CGU00646, Prince's Lodge Water and Sewer. The budget availability has been confirmed by Financial Services.

BY-LAW NUMBER L- 118 RESPECTING CHARGES FOR LOCAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

Be It Enacted by the Council for the Halifax Regional Municipality that By-Law L-100, the Local Improvement By-Law, be amended as follows:

1. Schedule "A" of By-Law L-100 is amended by adding the following:

Civic Address

- (a) The Prince's Lodge project is a plan to install sewer and water lines to service properties located within the boundaries identified on a plan entitled "Prince's Lodge, By-Law L-118, August 18, 2004" as attached.
- (b) The Project will be funded by local improvement charges based on the entire cost of the project less any federal, provincial or other revenue.
- (c) A local improvement charge will be imposed at an interim rate of \$6,850.00 per existing lot
- (d) A further local improvement charge will be imposed at an interim rate of \$6,850.00 per lot for those lots which, based on current HRM planning and zoning regulations, once serviced, would have the potential to be subdivided to create additional lots as follows:

- (e) The interim local improvement charges will be adjusted at the completion of the project, and will be calculated on the basis of the total actual cost of the project at the adjustment date, less any federal or provincial or other funding.
- (f) A further charge of six thousand, eight hundred and fifty dollars (\$ 6850.00) is hereby levied in respect of all future connections to the sewer and water systems for any properties, either existing or created, which are not assessed a local improvement charge.
