Award of Unit Price Tender No. 05-111, Sackville Transit Terminal

ORIGIN

The Approved 2005/06 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that Council:

- 1. award Tender No. 05-111, Sackville Transit Terminal Central Region to Dexter Construction Company Limited for materials and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Tender Price of \$1,405,602 including net HST from Capital Account No.'s CB300628, Bus Rapid Transit Showcase and CB200452, HRM Heritage Building Upgrades, with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications Section of this report.
- 2. appoint O'Halloran Campbell Consultants Limited to provide construction inspection services for an estimated fee of \$50,284 including net HST from Capital Account No. CB300628, Bus Rapid Transit Showcase, with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications Section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Approved 2005/06 Capital Budget included funds for the construction of a new transit terminal in Sackville.

The Sackville Transit Terminal will provide improved access to public transit for Sackville residents and is also focussed on "intercepting" automobile drivers on long commutes and offering them a transit alternative to continue their trip. The terminal will feature a large park-and-ride facility along with a terminal building that includes passenger waiting space. The terminal building will also include space for a new Sackville Visitor Information Centre.

This terminal will also form one of two origin points for the MetroLink Bus Rapid Transit service along the Windmill Corridor.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on June 22, 2005 and closed on July 8, 2005. The following bids, exclusive of taxes, were received:

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1.	Dexter Construction Company Limited	\$1,359,001.00
2.	W. Eric Whebby Limited	\$1,558,000.00
3.	Ocean Contractors Limited	\$1,881,214.00

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of the construction of a transit terminal building, public parking facility and a bus lay by and turn around area.

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

Since this project was designed by O'Halloran Campbell Consultants Limited it is recommended that they be retained to provide construction inspection services. The estimated fee for this service is \$48,616 plus applicable taxes. If approved, the payment to the consultant will be based on the amount of actual time spent on the project in accordance with the hourly fees approved by HRM.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$1,359,001, plus net HST for a total project cost of \$1,405,602, and a cost of \$50,284 for O'Halloran Campbell, funding is available in the Approved 2005/06 Capital Budget from Account No.'s CB300628, Bus Rapid Transit Showcase and CB200452, HRM Heritage Building Upgrades (note: this account includes Heritage Building Upgrades as well as allocations for Visitor Information Centres). The budget availability has been confirmed by Financial Services.
