

NATIONAL HOUSING DAY NOVEMBER 22, 2005

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the Halifax Regional Municipality, the Federation of Canadian Municipalities and other organizations across the nation have recognized that homelessness is a National Disaster and called on the Federal government to develop and implement a national housing strategy; and

WHEREAS the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) is advocating for a National Housing Strategy, and as a member of the FCM, the Halifax Regional Municipality endorses and supports a National Housing Strategy; and

WHEREAS communities across Canada are in the midst of an affordable housing crisis, and it is important for all levels of government, organizations and communities to work together to provide adequate and affordable housing that will make a real difference in the lives of many men, women and children who require shelter.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Peter J. Kelly, Mayor of the Halifax Regional Municipality, do hereby proclaim November 22, 2005, as "National Housing Day" in the Halifax Regional Municipality, and urge all levels of government and community organizations to work in partnership to implement a fully-funded National Housing Strategy for all of Canada.
