RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 06-112, for One (1) New 75 Foot Quint Fire Truck to Micmac Fire & Safety Ltd. for a Tender Price of \$731,720.00 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account No.CVJ00703 as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

DISCUSSION

Micmac Fire & Safety Ltd. will be supplying one (1) 2007 Pierce Model Dash 75' Quint Fire Truck. The new 75' Quint will be located at Fire Station 12, Highfield Park replacing unit # 90-57Q (75' Quint) which will be relocated to Station 41, Waverley. The existing 100' Quint in Station 41, Waverley will be declared surplus as it has reached the end of its useful life.

Delivery of the new unit is 365 calendar days from date of purchase order.
