# INFORMATION REPORT

# **ORIGIN**

October 10, 2006 (item 9.2) Petition from residents of Purcell's Cove Road regarding the extension of municipal services.

### **BACKGROUND**

At its meeting of October 10, 2006, Councillor Mosher served a petition on behalf of residents of Purcell's Cove Road requesting HRM to initiate a study to determine the total costs associated with extending central water and sewer services along Purcell's Cove Road.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Since the October 10/06 Council meeting, staff of Environmental Management Services (EMS) has completed a preliminary analysis of the results of the petition submitted. A meeting to update the District Councillor was held on November 30/06, attended by staff from EMS, Halifax Regional Water Commission, and Community Development. It was determined that further discussion with petition organizers should be held to determine whether or not they wish to conduct further canvassing of property owners. It was also determined that staff would prepare a letter that might be circulated by petition organizers, describing the steps involved in the process, a clear understanding of what property owners are being asked to commit to in signing the petition, and a description of the community planning/harbour planning exercise as it relates to the potential servicing extension along Purcell's Cove Road. This letter has been completed in draft form, and pending review by appropriate Business Units, will be forwarded through the Councillor to the petition organizers.
