**Subject:** Hammonds Plains Road Widening

**Request:**

Please add Hammonds Plains Road Widening to the Council agenda for Tuesday, September 25, 2007.

**Reason:**

I will be requesting a staff report on the widening of the Hammonds Plains Road, from the Kearney Lake Road to Highway 103. The Hammonds Plains Road is the busiest rural road in HRM, with an average of 15,000 vehicles per day. Hammonds Plains is the fastest growing area in Nova Scotia with nine large sub-divisions and an additional 2,500 approved lots. Along the stretch of road there are two golf courses, two large trucking companies, a large RV Park, four schools, four churches, two shopping malls and two additional shopping malls proposed in the near future. The area has a population of approximately 15,000, with an assessment of \$1,000,000,000.00. The road, which was paved and up-graded in 1957, was not built to accommodate this amount of traffic.
