INFORMATION REPORT

ORIGIN

As a result of a motion of Regional Council on September 11, 2007, Council requested staff provide a supplementary report regarding all commentary and concerns that were brought forward at the Public Hearing.

BACKGROUND

On September 11, 2007 a Public Hearing was held as per Regional Council's request. Staff were requested to prepare a report outlining the comments and concerns of the speakers present.
