ORIGIN

• The approved 2007/2008 Capital Budget

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Regional Council award Tender # 07-392 MacKintosh Fuel Depot Replacement to Redden Petroleum Enterprises Ltd.. in the amount of \$216,129.37 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account CBM00711, Fuel Depot Upgrades, as outlined in the budget implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The MacKintosh Fuel Depot, located in the Public Works Depot at 3825 MacKintosh Street, services all Business Units in Peninsular Halifax, and pumps 1.2 Million Litres annually. The current in ground fuel tanks and associated equipment are 20 years old and no longer meet government regulatory requirements. This Tender is to replace the fuel tanks, pumps and electronic inventory monitoring equipment at the same location.

DISCUSSION

Tender # 07-392 MacKintosh Fuel Depot Replacement closed on September 18, 2007. Bids were submitted from the following firms:
