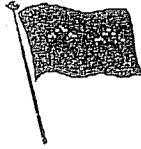

Remembrance Day ceremonies, honouring the men and women who gave their lives in wartime service and in defence of freedom, will occur throughout Canada at 11:00 AM Sunday, 11 November 2007. In Halifax, the ceremony will consist of a military parade and a religious ceremony at the Grand Parade Cenotaph. In addition, a 21-gun salute and wreath laying ceremonies will occur at various locations around the Halifax Regional Municipality.

In conjunction with the downtown parade, it is planned to have an aircraft from CFB Shearwater conduct a symbolic fly-past of the Grand Parade. As such, it is requested that HRM grant permission for the Canadian Forces to fly a Sea King helicopter (CH 124) over the city (routed north to south) at an altitude of 500 feet above the highest obstacles. This event will occur at approximately 11:02 AM on 11 November.
