**Subject: Charitable Fundraising on Municipal Streets**

**Request:** Please add the above item to the agenda for July 8.

**Reason:**

Parker Street Furniture Bank, and other charities, have been unable to continue fundraising on municipal streets as a result of amendments to the Motor Vehicle Act. Those amendments require the municipality to have a by-law to enable such fundraising activities.

I request a recommendation report relative to amendments to either the streets by-law or vending by-law to address the advisability of permitting, through no fee license, for fundraising activities on municipal streets as per the following section of the Motor Vehicle Act.

An Act to Amend Chapter 293 of the Revised Statutes, 1989,  
The Motor Vehicle Act

**13** Chapter 293 is further amended by adding immediately after Section 173 the following Section:

- 173A(1) .....(no person can collect money, etc)  
(2)..... (does not apply to emergency vehicles, tow trucks, etc)  
(3) Subsection (1) does not apply to fund-raising activities that are  
(a) permitted by a by-law of the municipality in which the activities are conducted; and  
(b) approved by the traffic authority responsible for the roadway on which the activities are conducted.
