Your Worship,

Remembrance Day ceremonies honouring the men and women who gave their lives in wartime service and in defence of freedom will occur throughout Canada at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, 11 November 2008. In Halifax, the ceremony will consist of a military parade and a religious ceremony at the Grand Parade Cenotaph. In addition, a 21-gun salute and the laying of wreaths will occur at various locations around the Halifax Regional Municipality.

In conjunction with the downtown parade, it is planned to have an aircraft from CFB Shearwater conduct a symbolic fly-past. As such, it is requested that HRM grant permission for the Canadian Forces to fly a Sea King helicopter (CH 124) over the city to the Grand Parade (routed north to south) at an altitude of 500 feet above the highest obstacles. This event will occur at approximately 11:02 a.m. on 11 November.
