 Inter-supply Lands, Kearney Lake Road

INFORMATION REPORT

<u>ORIGIN</u>

Regional Council Motion of June 24, 2008 (item #8.3)

BACKGROUND

Regional Council has requested information about the future redevelopment opportunities of the "Inter-supply" lands, owned by M.F. Schurman Company Limited and located on the north side of Kearney Lake Road (Map 1). There is a particular concern about environmental issues, due to its past use as a cement plant, and specifically the potential to negatively impact the water quality of Kearney Lake.

Based on discussions with HRM staff involved with water quality monitoring and the Department of Environment, there no known current issues with the property relative to the water quality of Kearney Lake. Additional information, should any exist, about the history of the property from the Department of Environment can only be obtained through a formal request to them.

The property is located within the Urban Settlement (US) Zone of the Mainland Halifax Land Use By-law. Although single family dwellings, semi-detached dwellings, and duplexes are permitted uses in this zone, there are no municipal services in the area. Regional Council recently adopted the Bedford West Secondary Planning Strategy, which encompasses a large area that includes the Intersupply Lands. It envisions that future development in this area will occur with the introduction of municipal services and take the form of a mixed use community, which would be considered through a development agreement. This exercise would include a review of the suitability of various sites for particular uses by assessing factors such as environmental conditions.
