SUBJECT: By-Law S-426, An Amendment To By-Law S-400, Respecting Charges

For Street Improvements, New Paving Projects Outside the Core Area

- 2007

#### **ORIGIN**

This report originates from staff.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council approve in principle By-Law S-426, an amendment to By-Law S-400, Respecting Charges for Street Improvements, New Paving Projects Outside the Core Area, in order to provide the funding necessary to recover HRM's share of the Aid-to-Municipalities Program with the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal in the amount of \$600,802.36 (net HST included), and begin the formal process for the adoption of the By-Law.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Each year, HRM submits a prioritized list of gravel roads outside the core area to the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal (NSDTIR) for consideration of paving under the Aid-to-Municipalities Program. The New Paving Projects of Subdivision Streets Outside the Core Area - 2007 were approved by Council in the 2007/08 Capital Budget. These projects are subject to Local Improvement Charges (LIC's).

Halifax Regional Municipality received an invoice from Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal on March 26, 2008 and payment of \$600,802.36 (net HST included) was made.

#### **DISCUSSION**

The following projects were approved by Council on June 19, 2007, under the Aid-to-Municipalities Program. Under this program, 50% of the cost will be shared by NSDTIR and 50% by HRM. The total HRM share is recovered by levying LIC's to abutting properties on these streets on a frontage basis. The approved estimated amount identified in the above noted Council Report was \$1,844,500 and included the following streets:

Lynwood Drive - Brookside - District 22
Ben Court - Brookside - District 22
West Avenue - Beaverbank - District 2
Osprey Way - Lawrencetown - District 3
Kerry Drive - Lawrencetown - District 3
Keltic Drive - Lawrencetown - District 3
Killarney Crescent - Lawrencetown - District 3
Kensington Court - Lawrencetown - District 3
Cambridge Drive - Lawrencetown - District 3

With a total project cost of \$1,201,604.71 (net HST included), HRM's share of the paving project is \$600,802.36. The total recoverable frontage is 25,740.16 feet. Therefore, the proposed frontage rate of \$23.34 per foot will provide the necessary funding to recover HRM's contribution of the project cost.

Pursuant To Administrative Order 32, a public hearing is not required on the enactment or amendment of a By-Law unless specifically directed by Council. In this case, the abutters would have been notified of the project and the anticipated amount of the LIC before the project was commenced. Initially the residents were surveyed at \$19 per foot of frontage. Due to the length of time and increase in construction materials, the residents were notified a second time that the estimated cost could be \$30 per foot.

In the end, the total cost of the project and the proposed LIC is less than \$30 per foot. Since the

recovery is in accordance with Council policy, it is staff's opinion that a public hearing in this instance would accomplish no useful purpose and might lead the abutters to the expectation that Council might reduce the amount of the LIC.

#### **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS**

Paving projects were approved under Capital Account No. CXU00585, New Paving of Subdivision Streets Outside the Core Area. HRM's share of the total project cost is \$600,802.36 (50%) (net HST included). HRM has reimbursed the Province its share as they were responsible for completing the work. HRM's cost is fully recoverable through Local Improvement Charges at the frontage rate of \$23.34 per foot. As cost recoveries were budgeted there is no change to the capital project budget.

#### FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT POLICIES/BUSINESS PLAN

This report complies with the Municipality's Multi-Year Financial Strategy, the approved Operating, Capital and Reserve budgets, policies and procedures regarding withdrawals from the utilization of Capital and Operating reserves, as well as any relevant legislation.

There are no recommended alternatives to this course of action.

# HALIFAX REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY

## By-law Number S-426

## Respecting Charges for Street Improvements, New Paving Projects

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Council of the Halifax Regional Municipality that By-Law Number S-400, the By-Law Respecting Charges for Street Improvements, Section 2 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 2 of By-Law S-400 is amended by adding as Subsection (15) the following:

"Notwithstanding Subsections (1), (2) and (3) a charge is hereby imposed on those areas listed in Schedule " M" as is more particularly set out in that Schedule "

#### **SCHEDULE "M"**

- 2. The Local Improvement Charges for properties fronting or abutting in whole or in part, Lynwood Drive and Bens Court in the area identified on the "Plan Showing Lynwood Drive & Bens Court Plan No. 1, dated April 16, 2008," attached hereto, shall be \$23.34 per foot.
- 3. The Local Improvement Charges for properties fronting or abutting in whole or in part, on West Avenue in the area identified on the "Plan Showing West Avenue Plan No. 2, dated April 16, 2008," attached hereto, shall be \$23.34 per foot.
- 4. The Local Improvement Charges for properties fronting or abutting in whole or in part, on Osprey Way ,Kerry Drive, Keltic Drive, Killarney Crescent, Kensington Court and Cambridge Drive , "Plan No. 3, dated April 16, 2008," attached hereto, shall be \$23.34 per foot.
- 5. The Local Improvement Charges imposed under this Schedule may be paid over a 10-year period with interest. Notwithstanding Section 4 of By-Law Number S-400, the unpaid balance is subject to an interest rate based on the maximum of the prime rate as set by the Royal Bank of Canada plus 2% at time of notification.
