ORIGIN

The 2008/2009 Approved Capital Budget

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 09-025, for the Rebuild of Engines & Gear Boxes, for the Woodside 1 Ferry to Atlantic Tractors & Equipment Ltd. for a Tender Price of \$145,736.00 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account No. CVD00436 as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Halifax Regional Municipality operates three (3) ferries that travel across the harbour between Halifax and Dartmouth. One of the vessels, the Woodside 1, requires work to rebuild the engines and gear boxes to meet the inspection schedule mandated by Ship Safety. The work is scheduled to take place in April.
