SUBJECT: Award - Tender No. 09-042, Pavement Markings - East and Central

Regions

ORIGIN

Ongoing operational requirements and Proposed 2009/10 Operating Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council:

- 1. award Tender No. 09-042 Pavement Markings East and Central Regions to Carvery's Painting Limited for material and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Total Tender Price of \$81,296.23 (net HST included) for Year One (1) on the contract, May 15, 2009 to September 30, 2009 with funding from Operating Account No. R747 6399 Traffic Signs as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report;
- 2. approve the award for Year Two (2) of the contract, May 15, 2010 to September 30, 2010 to Carvery's Painting Limited for \$84,171.55 (net HST included) contingent upon an annual performance review and budget allocation;
- 3. approve the award for Year Three (3) of the contract, May 15, 2011 to September 30, 2011 to Carvery's Painting Limited for \$86,043.62 (net HST included) contingent upon an annual performance review and budget allocation.

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BACKGROUND

The overall Traffic Marking Program includes two separate categories. The first category is the repainting of traffic lines, including centre lines, edge lines and lane lines, which represents approximately 60% of the Traffic Marking Program and is carried out by HRM staff.

The second category is the repainting of pavement markings including traffic arrows, crosswalks, stop bars and other miscellaneous traffic symbols, and represents approximately 40% of the Traffic Marking Program. Approximately 90% of this maintenance activity is carried out by contract services with the remaining 10%, mainly channelization lines, and late in the season new street markings, carried out by HRM staff.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on April 1, 2009 and closed on April 15, 2009. Bids were received from the following companies for a Three (3) Year contract:

This contract includes the repainting of existing pavement markings and traffic lines, as well as painting of new markings on HRM streets as directed by staff. The project will begin as soon as weather permits in May and continue for a period of approximately twelve weeks. The requirement to carry out the work of this tender within the time frame specified, weather permitting, has been emphasized in the tender document.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Supervisor.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tender price of \$251,511.40, including net HST, funding in the amount of \$81,296.23, including net HST will be made available for the first year of the contract in the 2009/2010 Operating Budget for Traffic Signs, in cost centre R747-6399.
