#### **ORIGIN**

The Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 06-244, Street Improvement Projects - various locations to Dexter Construction Company Limited for materials and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Tender Price of \$1,205,982 including net HST from Capital Account No. CZU00782, Resurfacing and Capital Account No. CRU00683, Concrete Curb Repair Program, with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications Section of this report.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget included funds for the resurfacing of various streets throughout HRM and the replacement of concrete curb and gutter on Peddars Way and Mount Edward Road.

### **DISCUSSION**

Tenders were called on July 8, 2006 and closed on July 19, 2006. The following bids, exclusive of taxes, were received:

1. Dexter Construction Company Limited	\$1,166,000.00
2. Lafarge Canada Inc.	\$1,296,825.00
3. Basin Contractors Limited	\$1,313,415.00
4. Ocean Contractors Limited	\$1,410,200.00

The scope of work for this tender generally will consist of cold planing, supply, placement and compaction of asphalt, concrete curb and gutter and associated reinstatement.

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award and take twelve weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

#### **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS**

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$1,166,000 plus net HST for a total project cost of \$1,205,982, funding is available in the Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget from Account No. CZU00782, Resurfacing and Account No. CRU00683, Concrete Curb Repair Program. The budget availability has been confirmed by Financial Services.
