ORIGIN

The Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No.06-250, Paving Renewal, Sidewalk Renewal, and Curb Renewal, Summit Street - West Region to Ocean Contractors Limited for materials and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Tender Price of \$522,285 including net HST from Capital Account No. CYU00784, Paving Renewal, Capital Account No. CKU00783, Sidewalk Renewals and Capital Account No. CRU00683, Concrete Curb Repair Program, with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications Section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget included funds for the paving renewal of Summit Street from Oxford Street to Gladstone Street, sidewalk renewal on Summit Street from Oxford Street to Dublin Street (north side) and from Dublin Street to Windsor Street (south side) and Curb Renewal on Summit Street from Oxford Street to Windsor Street.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on July 12, 2006 and closed on July 21, 2006. The following bids, exclusive of taxes, were received:

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of paving renewal, sidewalk renewals, and curb renewals. The work includes removal of asphalt, placement of a gravel levelling course, placement of asphalt, and spot repairs to combined sewer from Oxford Street to Gladstone Street. The work also includes sidewalk renewal and new curb on the north side from Oxford Street to Dublin Street, sidewalk renewal and new curb on the south side from Dublin Street to Windsor Street and new curb only on the north side from Dublin Street to Windsor Street and 50% curb replacement on the south side from Windsor Street to Gladstone Street.

It is anticipated that work will commence in the month of August and take six weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$504,970 plus net HST for a total project cost of \$522,285, funding is available in the Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget from Account No. CYU00784, Paving Renewal, Capital Account No. CKU00783, Sidewalk Renewals, and Capital Account No. CRU00683, Concrete Curb Repair Program. The budget availability has been confirmed by Financial Services.
