

Subject: Motorhome dumping stations

Request: Please add the above item to the March 28th agenda

<u>Reason:</u> I would like staff to report on the cost and practicality of creating one or more dump stations for motorhomes in HRM. Currently one exists at Shubie Park Campground, however, access is difficult for large motorhomes on the narrow residential street. As well, cost has been indicated as an issue for many resident owner / operators. Some private businesses which used to operate such stations no longer do so leaving limited dump access within the HRM limits.



Local residents operating motorcoaches indicate that many US states and Canadian locations offer free or low cost dumping stations for visitors and resident owners of motorhomes in easily accessible locations. Some considerations should be whether partnerships with service stations would be appropriate and locations with relatively easy access.

I request a report to council examining issues related to Shubie Park and RV dump traffic (especially as a result of larger RVs), what costs would be involved in setting up additional stations, what cost would have to be recovered to ensure cost recovery, and the policy and procedure in other jurisdictions, especially New Brunswick.
