



RECOMMENDATION

Chebucto Community Council recommends that Halifax Regional Council:

2. Approve the proposed amendments to the Regional Subdivision By-Law, the Halifax Municipal Planning Strategy, and the Halifax Mainland Land Use By-law as provided in Attachments A, B and C of the staff report dated November 5, 2009.
