INFORMATION REPORT

ORIGIN

April 6, 2010 (item 9.2.2) - Petition to Regional Council requesting that the application submitted by Mountain View Mobile Home Park Limited, Case 01278, Lake Echo, be rejected.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

Mountain View Mobile Home Park Limited are proposing to develop lands in Lake Echo for a new mobile home park. In order to allow such a development, Mountain View has requested that the Planning Districts 8 and 9 Municipal Planning Strategy (MPS) and Land Use By-law (LUB) be amended to allow for their development as the current MPS policy does not permit such development. Regional Council initiated the amendment process at their June 23, 2009 meeting.

Staff are currently evaluating the application by Mountain View Mobile Home Parks Limited under Case 01278. A copy of the petition will be attached to the staff report for consideration by both Regional and Community Council.
