**SUBJECT:** Request for Speed Bumps - Valkyrie Crescent

## **INFORMATION REPORT**

#### **ORIGIN**

Item 9.2.1 raised at the Halifax Regional Council meeting of May 25, 2010.

Councillor Karsten submitted a petition containing 46 signatures on behalf of the residents of Valkyrie Crescent, Dartmouth, requesting that speed bumps be installed on Valkyrie Crescent as the danger of harm to children by reckless drivers, and those who use Valkyrie Crescent as a thoroughfare was far too great.

# **BACKGROUND**

Speed humps are constructed on HRM streets only under the Neighbourhood Short-Cutting Policy.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Valkyrie Crescent is a crescent street that connects to what is basically a larger crescent street - Cranberry Crescent. It is likely there is little short-cutting going on Cranberry Crescent, and hence there is certainly no short-cutting using Valkyrie Crescent. The Short-Cutting Policy applies only to streets with a significant proportion of traffic being short-cutting traffic. Thus the Policy does not apply to Valkyrie Crescent, and speed humps cannot be considered otherwise.
