# **INFORMATION REPORT**

### **ORIGIN**

Item 10.2.1 raised at the August 17, 2010 meeting of Regional Council.

# BACKGROUND

A petition was submitted by Councillor Walker from the residents of Palisade Place, Halifax, requesting No Parking from 8 am to 4 pm - Monday to Friday; signage at the beginning of the street and extended to where the circle begins; and a "Caution Children Playing" sign. The petition was signed by ten (10) households on Palisade Place, Halifax.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Palisade Place is a short, dead end residential street comprised of ten civic addresses. It measures nine metres wide along its straight portion and has an island in the middle of its cul-de-sac. Teachers from a nearby school park on both sides on weekdays which impedes driveway access/egress as well as service delivery vehicle (snow, garbage, etc.) access.

In view of these considerations and the unanimity of the residents in the petition, approval has been given to install, "No Parking, 8 am to 4 pm, Monday to Friday" signs as requested by the residents.

Caution "Children Playing" signs, are not approved for use in HRM or in Nova Scotia. Neither are they recognized for use in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Canada.
