### **ORIGIN**

The Approved Advanced 2011/12 Project Budget.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council award Tender No. 11-208, Street Planer Patching – Phase 1, East/West/Central Regions, to the lowest bidder meeting specifications, ARCP – Atlantic Road Construction and Paving Ltd., for a Total Tender Price of \$522,055.72 (net HST included) with funding from Project No. CYX01345 – Street Recapitalization, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

# **BACKGROUND**

The Approved Advanced 2011/12 Project Budget includes funds for the Street Planer Patching – Phase 1 - Various Locations.

## **DISCUSSION**

Tenders were called on March 21, 2011, and closed on April 7, 2011. Bids were received from the following companies:

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of the patching of various streets.

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award and take eight weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

# **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS**

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$522,055.72 (net HST included), funding is available in the Approved Advanced 2011/12 Project Budget from Project No. CYX01345 - Street Recapitalization. The budget availability has been confirmed by Financial Services.
