Subject: Proposed Amendments to By-Law A-300 Respecting Animals and Responsible Pet Ownership

Motion for Council to Consider:

That Council request staff to review By-Law: A-300 Respecting Animals and Responsible Pet Ownership, giving consideration to increasing fines for owners of dogs, who while running at large, attack another dog or person, to a minimum of \$1,000 and also hold owners responsible for expenses incurred as a result of the attack.

Further, that staff review By-Law: A-300 and give consideration to providing stricter enforcement of the muzzle order within the existing by-law, as well as the provision of stipulations that an owner of a vicious dog which attacked an animal or person be prevented from owning another dog, and that leashes for dogs be restricted to 2 metres in length.

Outcome Sought:

That By-Law A-300 be amended to include the provisions listed above.
