Subject: Street signage management on Non-100 Series Provincial Highways

The Province recently responded positively this past spring by providing legislative opportunity for the municipalities to implement measures regulating street signage along our secondary provincial highways.

Motion for Council to Consider:

That Regional Council request that a staff prepare a report to be presented to Council prior to the end of the year providing a workable package of enabling measures through proposed By-law and/or management agreements. The report would assist in the effort to activate the Province’s legislation for Municipalities to implement measures related to street signage along secondary provincial highways.

To be included as elements of delivery feasibility:

1. Consideration to matching HRM existing staff resources to the proposed number of provincial roads to be covered.
2. Information on the initial phased implementation response to the St. Margarets Bay Road/Peggys Cove gateway section road to the Exhibition Park;
3. Consideration to the required preliminary community engagement together with the probable employment of existing community partnership delivery models and their readiness to begin program implementation for next Spring 2012.
