SUBJECT: Removal of No Parking and Loading Zone – Dutch Village Road

INFORMATION REPORT

ORIGIN

A petition with ten signatures for the removal of no parking and loading zone signs on the corner of Dutch Village Road and Deal Street was submitted by Councillor Walker as item 10.2.1 at the March 20, 2012 meeting of Halifax Regional Council.

BACKGROUND

There is one short loading zone on the south side of Dutch Village Road in this section.

DISCUSSION

The HRM typically installs loading zones to provide a location for businesses to receive deliveries. If the nearby businesses do not require the loading zone and there is otherwise no other reason it should remain in place, Traffic Services support this change. A work order has been prepared for this removal of the loading zone.
