We requested the flypast from the Canadian Air Force and are awaiting confirmation that they will again be a part of our Opening Ceremonies at Citadel Hill National Historic Site. Through this letter I am asking that you acknowledge the fact that the Halifax-Dartmouth Canada Day Committee has made the arrangements for the flypast on July 1st, 2012 at 12:00pm, and that you understand there is a possibility of the aircraft(s) flying at levels of not less than 500 feet.

It is also my understanding that any request for a flypast over the Halifax Regional Municipality must be approved by Regional Council. Again, through this letter, I am requesting that our request be made to Regional Council at the next Council Meeting for their approval.
