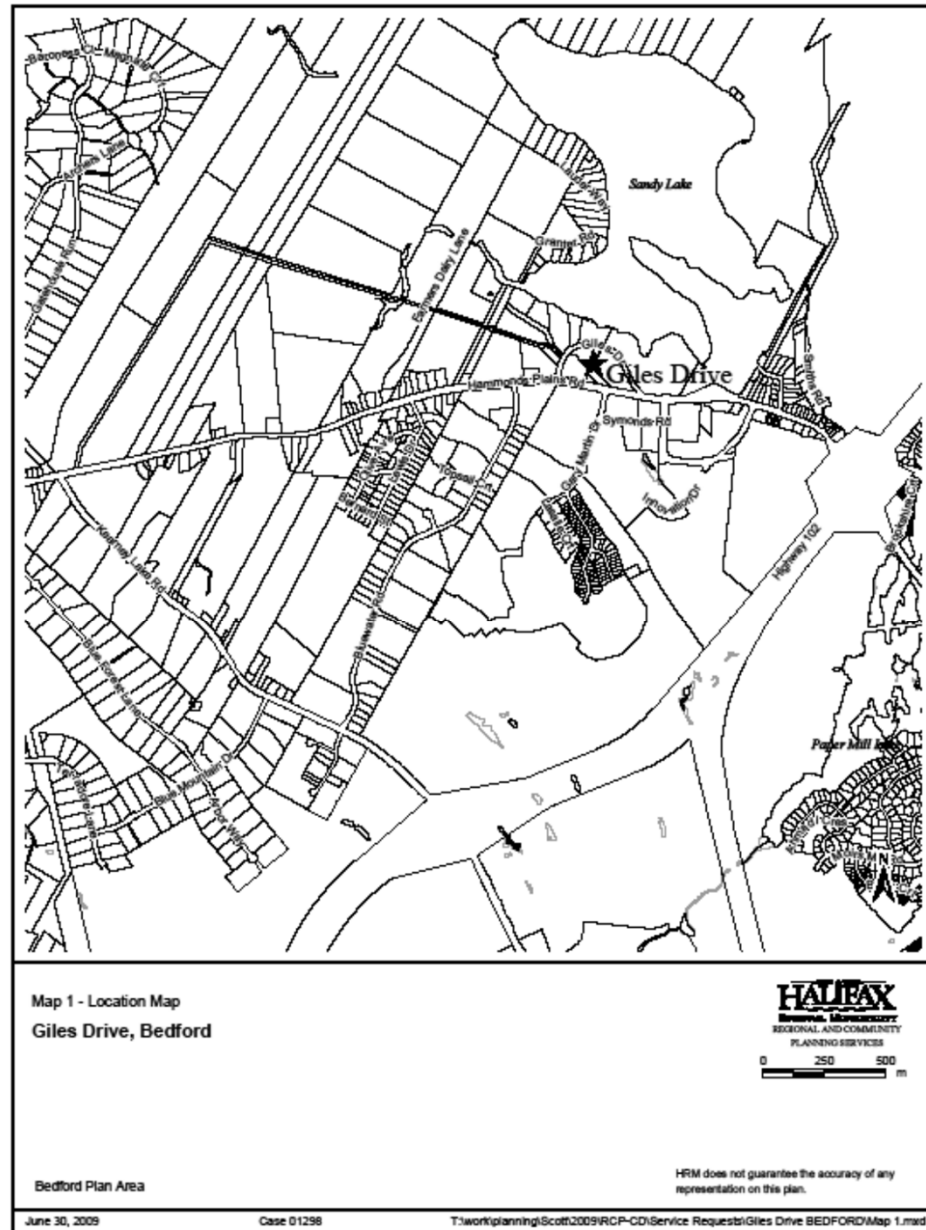

# LOCATION



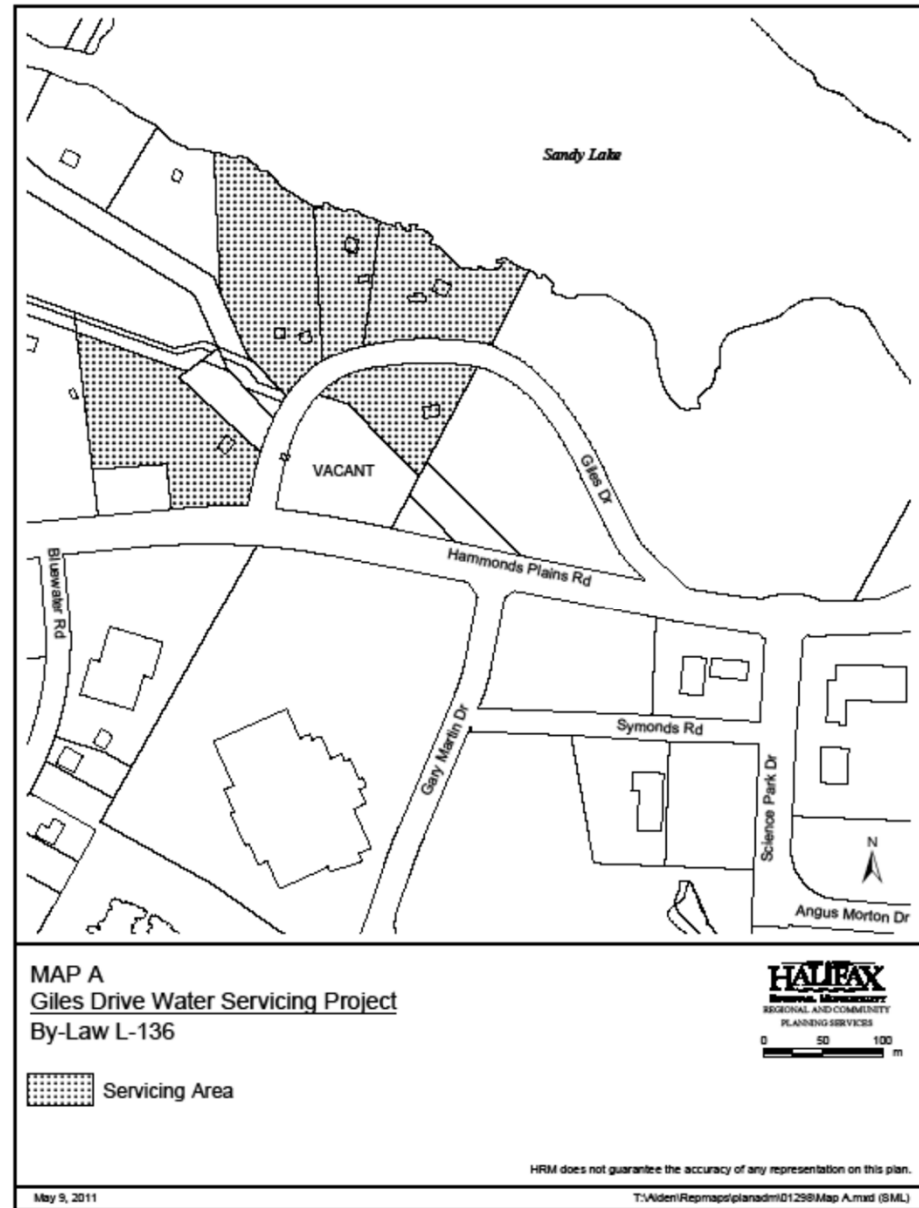
# ISSUES

# BACKGROUND

- Council Public Hearing August 2, 2011
- Council accepted a funding formula
  - \$50,000 West Bedford Holdings
  - \$50,000 Operating Account M421
  - \$50,000 LIC (\$10,000 each for five properties)

## STAFF RECOMMENDATION

- Increase LIC to \$13,588 from \$10,000

## COUNCIL MOTION

*That Regional Council repeal By-Law L-133, an amendment to By-Law L-100, to be replaced with By-Law L-136, as amended, to maintain the interim charge to be levied on each of the five properties at \$10,000, as presented in Attachment "A" of the April 25, 2012 staff report, and; decrease the amount indicated in the Budget Implications section of the April 25, 2012 staff report under Local Improvement Charge from \$67,940 to \$50,000 the difference of \$17,940; the difference to be funded from CTU 01006- Roadway Oversizing Bedford West thereby reducing the balance.*
