SUBJECT: **Minor Correction, Information Item 1, Indian Harbour Lighthouse**

Mayor and members of Regional Council,

Please accept this memo to correct an error in the referenced Information Report. Following posting of the report on Friday, an error has been brought to the attention of staff by the NS Heritage Trust.

In the report, staff stated that the Indian Harbour Lighthouse was NOT on the list of lighthouse nominated for heritage designation. In fact Indian Harbour WAS on the list. This was an oversight.

This information does not change the conclusion of the report.

The last paragraph of the Background section of the report (bottom of page 2) currently reads: *By the May 29th deadline, thirteen of HRM's 19 surplus lighthouses were nominated for designation. These were Beaver Harbour, Betty Island, Chebucto Head, Devils Island, George's Island, MacNab's Island, Peggy's Point, Pennant Harbour, Sambro Harbour, Sambro Island, Sheet Harbour, Spry Bay, and Terence Bay. The Indian Harbour lighthouse was not nominated.*

It should read (CAPS EMPHASIS ADDED): *By the May 29th deadline, FOURTEEN of HRM's 19 surplus lighthouses were nominated for designation, INCLUDING THE INDIAN HARBOUR LIGHTHOUSE. THE OTHERS were Beaver Harbour, Betty Island, Chebucto Head, Devils Island, George's Island, MacNab's Island, Peggy's Point, Pennant Harbour, Sambro Harbour, Sambro Island, Sheet Harbour, Spry Bay, and Terence Bay.*
