SUBJECT: Cost Sharing Agreement – Nova Scotia Department of Transportation

and Infrastructure Renewal - Rehabilitation to Various Bridges

ORIGIN

The Approved 2012/13 Project Budget.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Under the HRM Charter, Section 79 Halifax Regional Council may expend money for municipal purposes. Administrative Order #35, the Procurement Policy, requires Council to approve the award of contracts for sole sources exceeding \$50,000 or \$500,000 for tenders and RFP's.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign an agreement with the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal for \$99,071.70 (net HST included) with funding from Project Account No. CRU01077 Bridge Repair Program, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Approved 2012/13 Project Budget includes funds for the rehabilitation of cost shared bridges with the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal. As per Maintenance Agreement HRM-08, HRM agrees to contribute 50% towards the cost of maintaining bridge riding surfaces and bridge railings on all former cost shared routes.

DISCUSSION

On January 24, 2013 HRM received from the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal a proposed cost sharing agreement for the rehabilitation of three bridge structures. The three bridges are HRM BR114 Magazine Hill Overpass, HRM BR81 Barrington Street Outbound over Robie Street Inbound and HRM BR84 Barrington Street Inbound over Robie Street Inbound and Outbound.

The scope of work for BR114 Magazine Hill Overpass includes asphaltic concrete repaving of the bridge deck.

The scope of work for HRM BR81 Barrington Street Outbound over Robie Street Inbound and for HRM BR84 Barrington Street Inbound over Robie Street Inbound and Outbound includes concrete parapet wall and railing repairs.

It is anticipated work will commence as the weather permits in the Spring.

There are no local improvement charges associated with this work.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The estimated cost to HRM is \$95,000 plus \$4,071.70 HST for \$99,071.70 (net HST included). Funding is available in the Approved 2012/13 Project Budget from Project Account No. CRU01077 - Bridge Repair Program. The budget availability has been confirmed by Finance.

The balance of funds will be used to implement the remainder of the Bridge Repair Program as approved by Council.

Re: Cost Share Agreement - Rehabilitation on various bridges

Rehabilitation work is proposed on a number of structures included in the Maintenance Agreement HRM-08. Prior to the beginning of operations, a cost sharing agreement must be finalized between the Halifax Regional Municipality (HRM) and the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal (NSTIR).

The following is a list of bridges describing the cost shared work proposed, and the associated estimated costs. The work will be performed by the NSTIR forces with the possibility of having specific items completed by contractors. Note that while the rehabilitation is taking place, additional work may be carried out to these structures on components that NSTIR carry 100% of the maintenance responsibility. These costs are not reflected in the estimates below.

- HFX242 (BR114) Magazine Hill Overpass
 - → Asphalt concrete repaving over entire bridge deck
 - → Estimated cost \$30,000 HRM Portion \$15,000.00
- HFX456 (BR81) Barrington St. Outbound, over Robie St. Inbound
 - → Concrete parapet wall and bridge rail repairs
 - → Estimated cost \$80,000 HRM portion \$40,000.00
- HFX454 (BR84) Barrington St. Inbound, over Robie St. Inbound & Outbound
 - → Concrete parapet wall and bridge rail repairs
 - → Estimated cost \$80,000 HRM portion \$40,000.00

Total HRM portion of the proposed work on all three structures is \$95,000.00. If in agreement with the proposed work and estimated cost, please ensure that the following is signed and returned to my attention.
