# **ORIGIN**

The Audit and Finance Standing Committee meeting of April 3, 2013.

# **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

Halifax Regional Municipality Council approved, Dec 11, 2012, that all budget increases are to be presented to the Audit and Finance Standing Committee, prior to submission to Council.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

The Audit and Finance Standing Committee recommends that Halifax Regional Council approve an increase to Project No. CVD00431 - Midlife Bus Rebuild by \$350,000 with a corresponding decrease to Project No. CVD00435 - Conventional Bus Replacement by \$300,000, and a decrease to Project No. CVD00434 - Conventional Bus Expansion by \$50,000 as outlined in the Financial Implications section of the March 13, 2013 staff report.

# **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

Under the HRM Charter, Section 79 Halifax Regional Council may expend money for municipal purposes.

# **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Audit and Finance Committee recommend that Halifax Regional Council approve an increase to Project No. CVD00431 - Midlife Bus Rebuild by \$350,000 with a corresponding decrease to Project No. CVD00435 – Conventional Bus Replacement by \$300,000, and a decrease to Project No. CVD00434 – Conventional Bus Expansion by \$50,000 as outlined in the Financial Implications section of this report.

### BACKGROUND

Project No. CVD00431 - Midlife Bus Rebuild is used by Metro Transit Bus Maintenance. The goal of the bus rebuild program is to extend the productive useful life of a conventional bus from 14 years to 20 years.

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In order to achieve this, a midlife rebuild/refurbish is completed at year 12. The benefits to the bus rebuild are improved safety, corporate image and reliability, decreased downtime and improved compliance to Utility and Review Board (UARB) legislative requirements.

The tasks involved with this project are to rebuild the engine, transmission and differential, replace the corroded structural components and paint the entire bus.

### **DISCUSSION**

The costs related to the Midlife Bus Rebuild are initially charged to Metro Transit Operating account R935 and subsequently settled to Project No. CVD00431. The costs are settled to a project account in order to properly account for the value of the asset as per HRM's Tangible Capital Asset Policy.

The 12/13 approved project budget for CVD00431 was \$65,000. This budget is insufficient for the annual costs charged to this project.

### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The budget availability has been confirmed by Finance.
