SUBJECT:	Award - Unit Price Tender No. 13-212, Caldwell Road and Hines Road, Pulverization – East Region		

ORIGIN

The Approved 2013/14 Project Budget.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Under the HRM Charter, Section 79 Halifax Regional Council may expend money for municipal purposes. Administrative Order #35, the Procurement Policy, requires Council to approve the award of contracts for sole sources exceeding \$50,000 or \$500,000 for tenders and RFP's.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Municipality award Tender No. 13-212, Caldwell Road and Hines Road, Pulverization – East Region, to the lowest bidder meeting specifications, Basin Contracting Limited for a Total Tender Price of \$666,753.58 (net HST included) with funding from Project Account No. CYX01345 – Street Recapitalization, as outlined in the Financial Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Approved 2013/14 Project Budget includes funds for the pulverization of Caldwell Road from MacDonalds Beach Road to Hines Road and Hines Road from Caldwell Road to the existing new asphalt.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called and posted to the Province of Nova Scotia's Procurement website on August 23, 2013 and closed on September 10, 2013. Bids were received from following companies:

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of the pulverization of the existing asphalt and replacing with new asphalt. As well the shoulders will be paved to improve conditions for cycling.

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award and take three weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of 639,351.00 plus net HST of 27,402.58, for a net total of 666,753.58, funding is available in the Approved 2013/14 Project Budget from Project Account No. CYX01345 – Street Recapitalization. The budget availability has been confirmed by Finance.
