Dear Mayor Savage;

On behalf the Royal Canadian Navy and the organizers of the 2015 Scotiabank Hockey Day In Canada taking place from February 11th until February 15th in Halifax I am seeking permission from Halifax Regional Council to use the airspace over the Halifax Waterfront.

As part of the events scheduled for the 2015 Scotiabank Hockey Day In Canada, the Royal Canadian Navy will be positioning the HMCS Charlottetown on the Halifax Waterfront opposite Queens Landing on Thursday, February 12th and will be hosting a ball hockey game on the flight deck of the ship. The media hosting (Rogers & CBC) the Scotiabank Hockey Day In Canada will be filming the game and using the footage as part of the overall promotion of the event during that weekend.

In addition to the Navy vessel, 12 Wing Shearwater has now made available a Sea King helicopter to do a fly over of the Halifax Waterfront and I am requesting permission from Halifax Regional Council to grant 12 Wing the ability to conduct a fly past over Halifax between 1:00 PM and 4:00 PM (3 hours) on Thursday, February 12, 2015, as part of the activity.
