ORIGIN

June 3, 2015 meeting of the Special Events Advisory Committee, Item No. 7.1.3

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

- Halifax Regional Municipality Charter, Section 79, (1) (av)
- Special Events Advisory Committee Terms of Reference, section 4.1 which states: "Advise Regional Council on all matters related to the allocation of the Special Event Reserve, Festivals & Events Grants and Summer Festivals Grants"

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Special Events Advisory Committee;

That Halifax Regional Council rescind the condition for "cost sharing equal to the remaining two-thirds of the host fee being provided from the Province of Nova Scotia and the Government of Canada" from the October 23, 2013 motion and replace it with "HRM's contribution be equal to half of the total public investment provided by the Province of Nova Scotia and Government of Canada", the result of which would be to reduce the municipal contribution for 2015 by \$50,000 to a total of \$250,000, as outlined in the discussion section of this report.

BACKGROUND

A staff report dated May 22, 2015 pertaining to the Nova Scotia Open & RBC Canada Cup was before the Special Events Advisory Committee at its meeting held on June 3, 2015.

For further information please refer to the attached staff report dated May 22, 2015.

DISCUSSION

The Special Events Advisory Committee reviewed this matter at its meeting held on June 3, 2015 and did not adopt the staff recommendation as concern was expressed regarding the proposed reduction in funding from the Federal Government. The committee proposed an alternative motion for the consideration of Regional Council which would reduce HRM's total contribution by \$50,000.00 for a total of \$250,000.00, or half of the combined total public investment for the host fee provided by the Provincial and Federal governments (\$300,000.00 Province of Nova Scotia, \$200,000.00 Atlantic Golf Association (Federal)=\$500,000.00 /2=\$250,000.00 total).

SUBJECT: 2015 Nova Scotia Open & RBC Canada Cup - Amendment

ORIGIN

October 22, 2013 Regional Council motion:

Moved by Councillor Johns, seconded by Councillor Whitman that Halifax Regional Council:

Approve \$300,000 from the Marketing Levy Special Events Reserve (MLSER) Q315 in each of the next three years (2014-16) to fund one-third of the hosting fee for a Web.com PGA Tour Stop in 2014, 2015 and an option for 2016 subject to:

- HRM securing the event,
- cost sharing equal to the remaining two-thirds of the host fee being provided from the Province of Nova Scotia and the **Government of Canada**, and
- approval of the respective budgets for 2014, 2015 and the option for 2016.

MOTION PUT AND PASSED

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Halifax Regional Municipality Charter, Section 79, (1) (av)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Special Events Advisory Committee recommend that Halifax Regional Council rescind the condition for "cost sharing equal to the remaining two-thirds of the host fee being provided from the Province of Nova Scotia and the **Government of Canada**" from the October 23, 2013 motion and replace it with the condition of "cost sharing equal to the remaining two-thirds of the host fee being provided from the Province of Nova Scotia, **Government of Canada or any other sponsor**".

BACKGROUND

On October 22, 2013, Halifax Regional Council approved an event grant of \$300,000 per year for the web.com PGA tour in 2014, 2015 and option for 2016. The motion included a condition for "cost sharing equal to the remaining two-thirds of the host fee being provided from the Province of Nova Scotia and the Government of Canada".

DISCUSSION

The 2015 Nova Scotia Open and RBC Canada Cup will take place from July 2nd to July 6th at the Ashburn Golf Club-New Course. The organizers of this web.com Tour, the Sportbox Group, have indicated that one of the original funders - the Government of Canada, has been replaced by the Atlantic Golf Association and the funding commitment has been reduced from \$300,000 to \$200,000 as indicated in the attached funding letter (Attachment 1). Sportbox has also indicated that the remaining \$100,000 of the host fee is being covered through corporate sponsorship.

The original Regional Council motion included a condition for "cost sharing equal to the remaining two-thirds of the host fee to be provided from the Province of Nova Scotia and the Government of Canada". As a result of the changes in the funding, new direction from Regional Council is required.

The amount to fund this event remains at \$900,000 and is now split between the following funders:

1. a grant of \$300,000 from HRM;
2. a grant of \$300,000 from the Province Nova Scotia (Attachment 2);
3. a grant of \$200,000 from Atlantic Golf Association; and
4. \$100,000 through corporate sponsorship.

As these current changes are related to one of the government funders, as well as the distribution of funds, the original motion must be amended in order to proceed with the finalizing of the 2015 funding agreement.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The funding for the Nova Scotia Open has already been approved and reserved in the MLSER Reserve (Q315); therefore, there are no financial implications.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT
