<b>Subject: Request for Staff Report</b>		
<b>Motion for Council to Consider:</b>		
<p>I request Regional Council to ask for a staff report to amend the Halifax / Nova Scotia / Building Canada Fund Infrastructure Project list to include a central water distribution and sewage treatment collection project for the village core area of Musquodoboit Harbour based on a medium growth development scenario.</p> <p>This would amend the previous motion of HRM Council of July 29/14 that approved its priority project lists.</p> <p>The scope of the work required is in two phases.</p> <p>The first step is to request tripartite funding for the costs associated with the complete drafting of detailed design work and construction drawings for a central water and sewer treatment distribution system based on the Medium Growth Development Scenario as portrayed in the Musquodoboit Harbour Watershed Study.</p> <p>Secondly, once qualified construction estimates are secured, apply for the additional funding to do the installation of the infrastructure work. The recent CBCL Musquodoboit Harbour Watershed report estimates this to be in the \$40 Million range.</p>		
<b>Reason:</b>		
<p>Due to its status as a District Growth Centre in accordance with the RP+5 Plan, Musquodoboit Harbour should be included on the Building Canada Fund Infrastructure List.</p>
