Subject: Weekly Collection Service for Recyclables		
Request: That Halifax Regional Council request a staff report on implementing weekly collection service for recyclables throughout the municipality, including rural areas, commencing with the 2016/17 budget cycle.		
Reason: With the recent changes implemented with our solid waste collection, such as the requirement for clear bags, there is potential for an increase in recyclables being placed at the curb for collection. In anticipation of this potential increase, Council is asked to request a staff report to consider increasing collection service to a weekly schedule for recyclables across the municipality to meet the need.		
Outcome Sought: Staff report on implementing weekly collection service of recyclable throughout the municipality, including rural areas, commencing with the 2016/17 budget cycle.
