Subject: Dartmouth Museum	
Motion for Council to Consider: That Regional Council direct staff to prepare a staff report that:	
<ol> <li>Outlines the findings of the conservator's report on phase 1 of work on the DHMS artefact collection;</li> <li>Outlines a plan to work with stakeholders, including the Board of DHMS, to determine the size and scope of a municipal museum;</li> <li>Outlines the next steps in the completion of a municipal museum including allocation of capital funding and how it relates to the Cultural and Heritage Priorities Plan outlined in the January 28<sup>th</sup> motion and the subsequently requested Cultural Spaces Plan;</li> <li>Explains the relationships with and impact to other museums in HRM;</li> <li>Outlines potential short term options, including opportunities for displaying the artefacts; and</li> <li>Outlines potential cost sharing and fundraising opportunities.</li> <li>That Council direct staff to release the completed conservator's report that outlines the work completed on the artefacts and the ongoing requirements to maintain the collection.</li> </ol>	
<b>Reason:</b> Subsequent to the January 28, 2014 motion of Council related to a future municipal museum, with the revenue from the sale of 90 Alderney Drive expected to be received in 2016 for allocation towards the capital costs of a municipal museum. As well, as recommended in the Auditor General's report, HRM staff have used the services of a conservator to work with the Dartmouth Heritage Museum Society (DHMS) to bring the collection to an appropriate standard in terms of condition and inventory. <b>Outcome Sought:</b>
