Whereas 29 years ago this month, Halifax Mayor Ron Wallace and Grand Chief Donald Marshall Sr., recognized Nova Scotia's first Treaty Day; and

Every year since, Nova Scotians celebrate Treaty Day and the proud history, rich culture and important contributions of the Mi'kmaq people; and

It is also the 22th anniversary of Mi'kmaq History Month; and

Halifax Regional Municipality wishes to recognize the centuries-old treaties that have created an enduring bond of friendship and respect between Nova Scotia's Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal communities.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, I, Mayor Mike Savage, on behalf of the Halifax Regional Municipality, do hereby proclaim October 1st, as Mi'kmaq Treaty Day in Halifax Regional Municipality, and further, extend Council's sincere best wishes to the Mi'kmaq Community as we mark this special milestone.
