

Proclamation

International Day to End Violence Against Sex Workers December 17, 2015

WHEREAS The International Day to End Violence Against Sex Workers calls attention to hate crimes and violence against sex workers everywhere; and

WHEREAS The stigma and discrimination faced by sex workers means their human rights are denied and violence is done to them; and

WHEREAS Sex workers should have the right to report crimes committed against them without fear of subjecting themselves to prosecution because of their profession; and

WHEREAS Sex workers are equally entitled to the same human rights and equal protection under the law as any other citizen;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Mayor Mike Savage on behalf of Halifax Regional Council, do hereby proclaim December 17^{th,} 2015 as the International Day to End Violence Against Sex Workers in the Halifax Regional Municipality.
