This year will mark the $25^{\text {th }}$ Anniversary of the Liberation of Kuwait and the Coalition declaration of a cease-fire. The Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) participation in the Coalition was named OP FRICTION and the anniversary of the military contribution will be commemorated by the CAF through the conduct of a number of events in Kuwait and across Canada.
