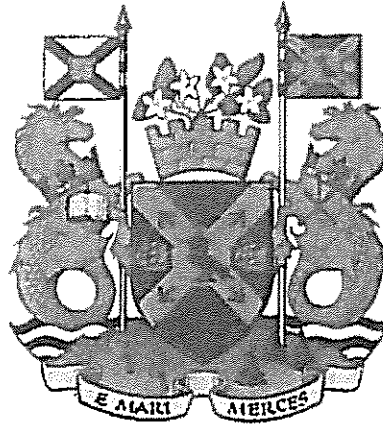

### **The Salvation Army Week December 12-18, 2016**

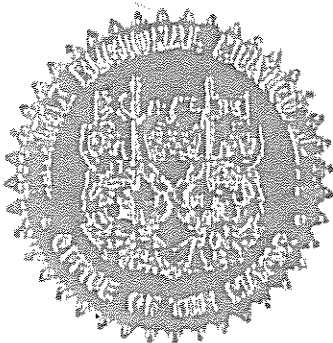
Whereas The Salvation Army is the largest non-governmental provider of social services in Canada, providing food, clothing and shelter in Halifax; and
