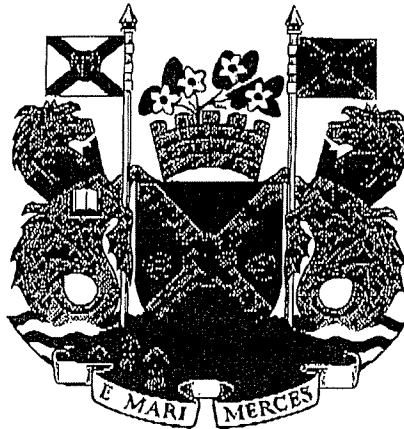

WHEREAS The Mi'kmaq Child Development Centre is an organization funded and supported by Public Health Agency of Canada; and

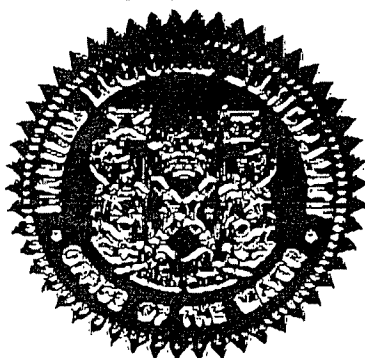
WHEREAS The Mi'kmaq Child Development Centre has been serving the urban Aboriginal population in Halifax Regional Municipality for 10 years; and


WHEREAS The Mi'kmaq Child Development Centre is a non profit organization committed to providing quality culturally appropriate programs and resources for the Aboriginal community; and
