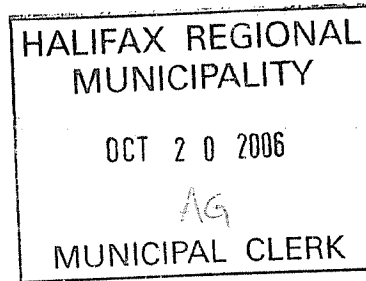

Remembrance Day ceremonies honouring the men and women who gave their lives in wartime service and in defence of freedom will occur throughout Canada at 11:00 a.m. Saturday, 11 November 2006. In Halifax, the ceremonies will consist of a military parade and religious ceremony at the Grand Parade Cenotaph. In addition, a 21-gun salute and wreath laying will occur at various locations around the Halifax Regional Municipality.

In conjunction with the downtown parade, an aircraft from CFB Shearwater plans a symbolic fly-past. In regards to the fly-past, it is requested the City grant permission for the Canadian Forces to fly a Sea King helicopter (CH 124) over the City of Halifax to the Grand Parade (north to south) at an altitude of 500 feet above the highest obstacles within the flight path at approximately 11:02 a.m. 11 November 2006.
