PROCLAMATION

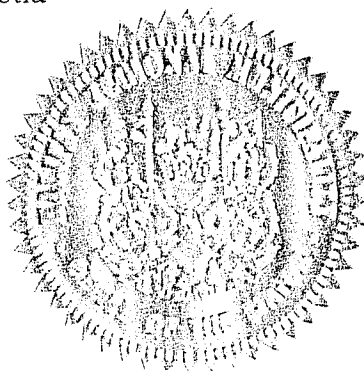


